Dikes and sills

Dike (dyke) – where magma fills and hardens in a crack in a rock. The crack cuts <u>across</u> older rock.
Example - Enfield dikes on the Vanished World Trail
Note - there is no car parking and no public access to this site

Sill – Where the magma hardens under the surface but in the same orientation as other layers of rock
Example - Tokarahi Sill on the Vanished World Trail
Note - there is no car parking and no public access to this site
